SCHEDULE AND
FORMAT**

Country Quota Playoff: to be played after 2:00 pm the day before the Qualification Tournament (for Women event in conjunction with the practical part of the referee clinic).

Qualification Tournament:

Women: June 27th

Men: June 28th

Main Draw and Finals:

Women: June 28th – July 1st , semifinals and finals July 1st

Men: June 29th – July 2nd , semifinals & finals July 2nd

The Qualification Tournament (1 day) will be preceded by the "Country Quota Playoff" matches (with a single elimination format) to determine the teams eligible to participate in the Main Draw through the Qualification Tournament.

The Qualification Tournament (i.e. 32 teams for Grand Slam events at the completion of the "Country Quota Playoff" matches) will consist of a single elimination format.

The Main Draw (4 days) will be based on the pool play format.

The preliminary matches of the Main Draw are based on the Pool play system: 8 groups with 4 teams each ; Round Robin.

Pool seeding: - The 8 Pools will be fixed with 3 of the 4 teams 13 days before the start of the tournament. The 4th team in each pool will come from the qualification tournament.- The highest seeded team from the Qualification tournament (as per the athletes' 365 - day FIVB World Ranking points on the day before the event – Technical Meeting-) will be seeded as number 25, the second seeded team will be as number 26, the third seeded team will be as number 27, etc. etc. through 32.
- If the host country teams are seeded 9 and 10, an eventual wild card team from the host country should be seeded 22 to avoid two teams from the host country in the same pool.

- In case of a withdrawal less than 13 days before the start of the tournament, the highest seeded team AFTER the country quota playoff will take over the position of the team that withdrew. This team could potentially be seeded number 1 through 24.

1st. – 2nd and 3rd place in each pool get out of the pool and earn the right to play in the single elimination format.

The 4th placed team in each pool will get the finish 25th, 26th, 27th, 28th, 29th, 30th, 31st and 32nd, following the criteria of the best ratio (wins, sets, points).

The **final phase** of the Main Draw consists of a **single elimination format** with 24 teams where:

The winners of all pools are directly qualified for the 8th final:

- The team with best ratio (wins, sets, points) out of pool A and B, will be seeded number 1. The other team is seeded number 2.

- The team with best ratio (wins, sets, points) out of pool C and D, will be seeded number 3. The other team is seeded number 4.

- The team with best ratio (wins, sets, points) out of pool E, F, G and H, will be seeded number 5. The second, third and fourth team is seeded number 6, 7 and 8.

The number 2 and 3 teams of each pool play against each other to qualify for the 8th final:

- The four number 2 teams with best ratio (wins, sets, points) out of all pools will play versus the four number 3 teams with worst ratio out of all pools. The opponents are decided by draw.

- The four number 2 teams with worst ratio (wins, sets, points) out of all pools will play versus the four number 3 teams with best ratio out of all pools. The opponents are decided by draw.

- Always, in case of a tie, it will be broken as in the Olympic Games in Athens (First Head to Head record (when possible), then number of set won, point ratio).

The winners of the 2 semi-finals will play the finals for the 1st and 2nd place while the losers will play the finals for the 3rd and 4th place.

Please note that the Prize Money for the men's and woman's athletes will then be reduced accordingly.</p> <p>The 2006 Prize Money of the events of a certain month will be paid by the FIVB to the athletes at the end of the following month at the latest.</p> <p>The FIVB Bonus Pool will be paid to the eligible athletes signing the FIVB/NF-Athlete agreement, fulfilling all remaining FIVB Regulations, as well as executing and delivering their full commitment to the FIVB Rules.</p> <p>In 2006, the FIVB shall pay the full Bonus Pool and travel allowance to the eligible athletes who play in at least 8 SWATCH FIVB events and the majority of Grand Slam events (if the required ranking points are obtained) under the condition that an agreement was signed).</p> <p>Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event that the Athlete does not participate in 2006 in a minimum of 8 events, he/she will still be able to earn Bonus Pool and Travel allowance at a reduced rate as set forth below. PLAYERS' ELIGIBILITY	<p>Only players who sent in to the FIVB in due time the required forms (2006-2008 FIVB-National Federation - Athlete' Agreement duly signed by all parties) and in good standing with the FIVB will be considered eligible to take part into the 2006 SWATCH FIVB World Tour events.</p>
ENTRY (FIVB WEBSITE)	<p>The confirmed teams' entry list as well as useful information related to the event are enclosed to this Event's Regulations and available on the FIVB website. Entry Points are the sum of individual ranking points based on the best 4 out of the last 5 FIVB Open, Grand Slam, and World Championships participations within the last 365 days.</p>
FORFEIT	<p>Each National Federation is responsible for informing immediately both the FIVB and the Organizers in case of forfeit of an enrolled team through the WT/03 form (from -13 days to the start of the event)</p>
PRELIMINARY INQUIRY AND TECHNICAL MEETING	<p>Athletes must attend the Preliminary Inquiry. Athletes' attendance at the Technical Meeting is mandatory. If required, a drawing of lots will be made during the meeting to break any eventual ties. Match-up seeding and additional detailed information on the competition will be distributed on the occasion of the Technical Meeting. Athletes may be requested to provide their ID card or passport during the Technical Meeting.</p>
UNIFORMS AND ACCESSORIES	<p>If required by the FIVB Technical Supervisor, uniforms and accessories will be checked during the Preliminary Inquiry. Athletes of the same team must wear the same color and style of shorts. The display of the individual players' sponsors' logos on shorts and accessories must comply with the FIVB advertising regulations. While tank tops will be provided by the Organizers to the athletes, shorts/bottoms and accessories must be provided by the players and/or by their sponsors. Uniforms will also be provided by the Organizers to officials Organizing staff members and volunteers.</p>

WELCOME AND LOCAL TRANSPORTATION	<p>The Organizer will welcome Qualification and Main Draw players at Sola International Airport and will take care of the local transportation from the Airport to the hotel, provided that the teams send their detailed travel itinerary (WT/31) until Friday June 23 to Fax No: + 47 51 97 16 81</p> <p>Local transportation for any other persons, like coaches, guests, teams' physiotherapists, friends, or family members will not be under the responsibility of the promoter.</p>
TRANSPORTATION	<p>The FIVB will financially participate in the mains draw athletes' International transportation as per the FIVB-NF-Athlete Agreement with a flat fee per event.</p> <p>Main Draw athletes will be eligible free of charge for all local transportation to/from the airport and to/from the hotel through the Event Organisers.</p> <p>Athletes (or their National Federations) will be requested to apply early enough for their entry visas, whenever needed and will be accountable for all visa expenses.</p>
BOARD AND LODGING	<p>Qualification Tournament teams will be responsible for their own expenses including, but not limited to, airfare, visa, hotel¹, food and miscellaneous expenses</p> <p>The organizers will provide the Main Draw teams (including the athletes proceeding from the Qualification Tournament into the Main Draw) with hotel accommodation (double room) in the Organizer's designated Hotel and with meals from the evening before the start of the Main Draw for three nights. The FIVB will provide the Main Draw teams with hotel accommodation (double room) in the Organizer's designated Hotel and with meals with an additional night (fourth night). The promoter will also pay for the finalist teams an additional night on Saturday for the women and on Sunday for the men.</p> <p>Athletes will be personally responsible for all extras at the hotel such as mini-bar, phone calls, laundry, etc. to be paid upon checkout.</p> <p>The organizers will not be required to make reservations for coaches, guests, teams' physiotherapists, friends, or family members accompanying the participating athlete.</p>

<p>ACCREDITATION</p>	<p>Organizers will provide all Organizing Committee members, FIVB Officials, referees, athletes, VIP's, journalists, technical staff, court personnel, volunteers, etc. with an official accreditation card and will ensure that only people with appropriate accreditation will access the designated venue areas. <p>WITHDRAWAL AND SANCTIONS</p>	<p>Withdrawal and/or disbanding of teams/athletes entered in the Main Draw is not allowed once the confirmed list has been announced, except in case of "force majeure" or in case an athlete is injured. In such cases, a Medical Certificate or a declaration of good faith must be provided to the FIVB before the beginning of the Technical Meeting of the Main Draw.</p> <p>In case of withdrawal and/or disbanding of teams/athletes entered in the Main Draw once the confirmed list has been announced without any Medical Certificate or declaration of good faith presented at the latest during the Technical Meeting of the Main Draw, the FIVB will apply a USD 3,000 fine. This fine must be paid before the start of the following event in which a team wants to enter (if no events are staged, the fine must be paid no later than 30 days from the notification of the sanction). The proof of the wire must be sent via fax to the FIVB.</p> <p>Athletes in the Main Draw may be replaced by any team member for reasons of "force majeure" for a 30 day period (keeping its Main Draw status) only once during the season, and for one Tournament only. In the event an athlete in the Main Draw is replaced by any team member for reasons of "force majeure" for a second time during the season, the team concerned will then lose its Main Draw status and be automatically placed in the Qualification Tournament.</p> <p>Withdrawal and/or disbanding of teams/athletes entered in the Qualification Tournament is not allowed once the confirmed list has been announced, except in case of "force majeure" or in case an athlete is injured. In such cases, a Medical Certificate or a declaration of good faith must be provided to the FIVB before the beginning of the Technical Meeting of the Qualification Tournament.</p> <p>In case of withdrawal and/or disbanding of teams/athletes entered in the Qualification Tournament once the confirmed list has been announced without any Medical Certificate or declaration of good faith presented at the latest during the Technical Meeting of the Qualification Tournament, the FIVB will then apply a USD 500 fine. This fine must be paid before the start of the following event in which a team would like to enter (if no events are staged, the fine must be paid no later than 30 days from the notification of the sanction). The proof of the wire must be sent via fax to the FIVB.</p> <p>Athletes who have not communicated their travel itineraries to the organizers and who arrive late for the Technical Meeting (i.e after the seeding is made) will be excluded from the event by the FIVB Technical Supervisor for "no show" or fined.</p> <p>Athletes failing to attend the Technical Meeting and who have not sent via fax the appropriate "force majeure" documents before the start of the event concerned will be sanctioned by the FIVB. Should it be proven that a National Federation is responsible for not communicating to the FIVB a Player's medical certificate for the withdrawal from an event, the National Federation shall be fined instead of the concerned Player.</p> <p>No changes between the teams enrolled in the Qualification and Main Draw Tournaments will be made after the beginning of the Technical Meeting of the Qualification Tournament.</p> <p>The FIVB Web site will be updated after every withdrawal and substitution of players approved by the FIVB once the confirmed list issued</p> <p>Notification for last minute withdrawals (i.e. on the day of a Technical Meeting) must be sent via fax to the FIVB Beach Volleyball Department (+ 41 21 345 35 48) as well as to the organizers of the event and the FIVB Technical Supervisor at the venue office.</p>



INSURANCE	<p>Athletes must have their own liability and medical insurances. The FIVB, the Organizer/Promoter and the hosting National Federations will not be responsible for any medical expenses incurred while competing in a tournament. The FIVB will be responsible for issuing an insurance card for the top 100 men and 100 women players covering the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • in case of emergency treatment and hospitalization up to CHF 1,000,000 • in case of death up to CHF 50,000. • In case of invalidity CHF 100,000. • In case of assistance and repatriation the full travel costs will be covered upon original receipts.
MEDICAL CONTROLS	<p>The FIVB reserves the right to perform random medical controls to the participating athletes, as per FIVB rules and regulations and alcohol test to the officials.</p>
