- Alison Cerutti and Emanuel Rego have been playing together since 2010. They are playing in their 37th FIVB Beach Volleyball World Tour/Open tournament together.
- Alison is playing in his 35th FIVB World Tour/Open final four with 10 gold, 11 silver, 10 bronze medals and three 4th place finishes.
- Emanuel is playing in his 165th FIVB World Tour/Open final four with 76 gold, 35 silver, 40 bronze medals and 13 4th place finishes.
- This is Alison's and Emanuel's 2nd Final Four of 2013 (4th Rome Grand Slam).
- Alison and Emanuel won the silver medal in the Olympic Games in 2012 (London).
- Emanuel has played in all five Olympic Games. Besides 2012, he finished 9th with Ze Marco de Melo in 1996 (Atlanta), 9th with Jose Loiola in 2000 (Sydney), won the gold medal in 2004 (Athens) and the bronze medal in 2008 (Beijing), both with Ricardo Santos.
- Alison and Emanuel are the current World Champions, winning gold in the FIVB World Championships in 2011 (Rome).
- Alison won the silver medal in the FIVB World Championships with Harley Marques in 2009 (Stavanger).
- Emanuel has played in all eight FIVB World Championships, besides the gold in 2011 with Alison, he finished 5th with Ze Marco de Melo in 1997 (Los Angeles), was the World Champion with Jose Loiola in 1999 (Marseille), finished 5th with Tande Ramos in 2001 (Klagenfurt), was World Champion in 2003 (Rio de Janeiro), finished 17th in 2005 (Berlin), finished 4th in 2007 (Gstaad), and 5th in 2009 (Stavanger), all with Ricardo Santos.
- Alison and Emanuel are currently ranked 14th in FIVB World Tour/Open points in 2013 with 2,140 points and 7th in winnings with \$56,400.
- Alison and Emanuel rank 12th on the all-time FIVB World Tour/Open team gold medal list with seven.
- Alison and Emanuel rank 81st on the all-time FIVB World Tour/Open team tournament list with 37.
- Alison and Emanuel rank 11th on the all-time FIVB World Tour/Open team winnings list with \$785,300.
- Alison (10) ranks 14th and Emanuel (76) ranks 1st in all-time FIVB World Tour/Open individual gold medals.
- Alison (63) ranks 137th and Emanuel (228) ranks 1st in all-time FIVB World Tour/Open individual tournaments.
- Alison (\$543,350) ranks 21st and Emanuel (\$2,374,085) ranks 1st in all-time FIVB World Tour/Open individual earnings.

- Alison and Emanuel are the current FIVB World Tour Champions and were named Team of the Year in 2011.
- Emanuel is a 10-time FIVB World Tour Champion, besides last season with Alison, he won the points championship with Ze Marco de Melo in 1996 and 1997, with Jose Loiola in 1999, with Tande Ramos in 2001, and with Ricardo Santos in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2007. Emanuel and Ricardo were also named Team of the Year in 2005 (the inaugural season for the award), 2006, and 2007.
