## Photographer's Agreement

Rules applicable to photographers hired by the International Volleyball Federation, National Federations and Organizing Committees, during the 2008 SWATCH FIVB Beach Volleyball World Tour.

By virtue of the present document, the undersigned, as the official FIVB photographer for the abovementioned event, agrees to abide by the following rules:

- Photographs will be produced using a professional digital camera and will be posted in the photo gallery of the FIVB website and printed in colour.
- Photographs must meet the following criteria:
  - The digital camera used to take the photographs must produce files of at least five megapixels.
  - The files produced must be saved in JPG format in the Adobe Photoshop programme (minimum of eight on a scale from one to twelve).
  - The size of the files must be at least 2,200 pixels (longest side).
  - Except in special cases, the files must have a maximum exposure of 400 ASA.
  - All photographs must be of print-ready quality.
- Before the start of the tournament, the photographer will contact the VIS Department of the FIVB ([vis@fivb.org](mailto:vis@fivb.org)) in order to request the FTP codes and the password to send digital photographs.
- The photographer will carefully position himself so that the sponsors and the audience are in the background on the photographs, making them suitable for use in Beach Volleyball publicity.
- The photographer will give due attention to the FIVB sponsors and will be careful to take close-ups at events involving few spectators so that any partially empty background is less visible.
- Should President Acosta be present, the photographer will pay due attention to the President's requests for photographs of ceremonies with VIPs, of meetings, etc.

The Photographer shall provide the following photographs (please see attached checklist):

- a) Competition photos for media use
  - Action photos
  - Photos showing emotion
  - Shots of the spectators
  - Photographs of the entertainment, children having fun, TV and journalists covering the event
  - Photos of any VIPs, personalities
  - Panoramic photos of the stadium from outside the venue
- b) Photos for the FIVB website
  - Of the above photos, a minimum of 20 per day must be uploaded to the FIVB website
  - At the end of the last day of competition, a minimum of 20 photographs of the prize-giving ceremony must be uploaded to the FIVB website
- c) Post-event photos
  - After the event, CDs containing all original high-resolution photographs, as well as a minimum of 20 colour prints (15 x 20cm) must be sent to the FIVB by DHL

d) Media report

The following photographs must be provided as colour prints (13 x 18 cm) and files

- Min. 5 shots of each of the following: panoramic shots of the stadium; the beaches and venue/city centre; the crowd and full stands; VIPs and celebrities attending the event; post-match interviews and press conferences
- Min. 10 shots of the prize-giving ceremony and the podium
- Min. 10 shots of press infrastructure: working room, mixed zone, press conference room, pigeonholes, notice board, café/bar, communications facilities
- Min. 15 shots of TV equipment: camera positions, cameramen working during tournament, technicians, commentators, OB trucks etc.
- Min. 15 shots of all advertising panels in each sector (A, B, C, D); logo exposure, inflatables, net and referee stand, athletes, referees, ball retrievers, uniforms, photographers, time-out area, podium, scoreboard, flags etc.
- Min. 30 action shots of all Main Draw athletes
- Portrait pictures of all Main Draw teams
- Any other pictures including social activities, welcome or farewell dinner, technical meeting, press conferences, close-ups of trophies etc.

**Note:**

***The name of the photographer, date, topic of the pictures (i.e. name of the athletes, dignitaries, what they are doing) and location must be marked on the reverse side of each colour print.***

***Digital files should be captioned using File Properties in Adobe Photoshop (IPTC headers). The photographer's name should only appear in the "Taken By" field in File Properties. Photographers must check the caption field and delete all the File Property information that automatically appears in the caption field and write a correct caption. The text in the caption field must include the full names of all players/dignitaries, etc. in the photo and their country/countries and what they are doing. Please note: The text in the caption field (which appears on the FIVB website) must NOT INCLUDE the photographer's name or other File Property information.***

- Should the FIVB so request, the photographer will also take photographs using standard colour film.
- The photographer will not give or sell the photographs produced to third parties, except with the FIVB's prior agreement.
- The photographer agrees through this document to waive his/her copyright to all of the photographs he/she provides to the FIVB, FIVB partners and all media for all communication means for an unlimited period of time worldwide.
- The photographer provides the FIVB with any negatives that are produced.
