

OVERVIEW

The aim of this document is to provide the FIVB Officials with a standardised clear and concise method by which to communicate the results of the coin toss at Beach Volleyball matches.

During the all process of communication, referees must keep visual contact with the scorer and make sure the information is well received. Every piece of information must be confirmed before you move to the next.

The Scorers should pay attention to the coin toss and follow the process, however, only input information according to the 2nd referees' information.

1. THE POSSIBLE SCENARIOS

- After the 1st set coin toss.
- Between sets 1 and 2.
- Between sets 2 and 3.

2. AFTER THE 1ST SET COIN TOSS

- **What to communicate to the Scorer**
 - The team which won the toss
 - The choice of the team which won the toss
 - The choice of the other team
- **How to communicate with the Scorer**
 - Country + shirt color + winner of the toss
 - Serves or receives or the side (pointing to the side)
 - Other Country + shirt color + remaining choice
- **Example**
 - Brazil yellow, won the toss
 - They receive
 - Brazil green, that side (pointing to the side)

3. BETWEEN SETS 1 & 2

- **What to communicate to the Scorer**
 - The choice of the team who lost the 1st set coin toss
 - The choice of the other team
 - Service order of both teams
- **How to communicate with the Scorer**
 - First collect information from both teams, first move to the team who lost the 1st set toss
 - Country + serves or receives or the side (pointing to the side)
 - Other Country + serves or receives or the side (pointing to the side)
 - Countries + same service order or change service order
- **Example**
 - Brazil receives
 - Italy that side (pointing to the side)
 - Brazil same service order, Italy changes their service order

3. BETWEEN SETS 2 & 3

- **What to communicate to the Scorer**
 - The team which won the toss
 - The choice of the team which won the toss
 - The choice of the other team
 - Service order of both teams
- **How to communicate with the Scorer**
 - Country + winner of the toss
 - Same Country + serves or receives or the side (pointing to the side)
 - Other Country + serves or receives or the side (pointing to the side)
 - Countries + same service order or change service order
- **Example**
 - Italy won the toss
 - They receive
 - Brazil that side (pointing to the side)
 - Italy changes service order, Brazil same service order
