Concept	Athletes under 21 and under 19 competing to determine the best team in the world within these categories
Gender	Men & Women
Periodicity	2017: U21 2018: U19
Stadium	Min. 1500 seats
Facilities	As per current FIVB Handbook incl. office space, meeting rooms, medical facilities, press area, etc.
Courts	4 courts + 2 warm up courts, fully equipped as per FIVB requirements standards
Competition Days	5- 6 days

Entry – Continental Quota	<p>Universal Qualification through the 5 Continental Confederation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Continental Confederations Entry Deadline: -60 days - National Federation Entry Deadline: -59 until -50 days - Confirmed Team Entry List: -45 days
National Federation Quota	<p>Host Country: 2 teams per gender</p> <p>Each National Federation: 1 team per gender's event per country is accepted; however a 2nd team from a same country may be selected if needed to fill the roster.</p>
Competition Format	<p>→ max 24 teams Qualification Tournament played in single elimination format; 4 teams to qualify in the MD</p> <p><u>Preliminary phase</u> 32 teams Main Draw tournament play in Pool Play (8 pools, 4 teams per pool) with 24 teams advancing to the single elimination round.</p> <p><u>Final phase:</u> 2-3 days' single elimination with 24 qualified teams. The winner of the semi-final games will play the gold medal match while the loser of the semi-final will play the bronze medal match.</p>
Seeding	<p>As per FIVB Specific Competition Regulations.</p> <p>Only the first result of a country from the previous age group World Championships will be taken into consideration. If a country has more teams in the event, only the first team will have the benefit of the points. All remaining teams from the country concerned will have 0 points.</p> <p>The first host country team will be seed 1. The 2nd host country team will be seed 8.</p>
Coaches	<p>NEW rule –tested in 2014 - Coaching permitted in Age Groups World Championships</p> <p><u>Note:</u> these are <i>not changes to the rules of Beach Volleyball</i> – but have been decided by the Executive Committee of FIVB and are specific to certain FIVB and Continental competitions where coaching has been permitted. In fact, the rules for the players are unchanged, but in this updated guidance they have been augmented to include how to cover situations not currently covered in the rules.</p> <p>Please refer to the Specific Competition Regulations regarding matches where coaching is permitted or to the 2016 Age Group Handbook for more information. (This is subject to update as per the decision of FIVB.)</p>

FIVB World Ranking points	YES - FIVB World Ranking Points are earned by <u>each player</u> competing in this kind of events.																		
Calendar date	Agreement between the FIVB & the Organisers, possibly facilitating the participation of these categories of athletes.																		
Awards	Medals and trophies for the World Champion, 2 nd place and 3 rd place. The winning teams of the FIVB U19 and U21 World Championships will be granted a wild card for a Main Draw tournament at an FIVB Beach Volleyball event (possibly in the Open but not restricted to Grand Slam or Major Series tournament) of the same season or of the following season.

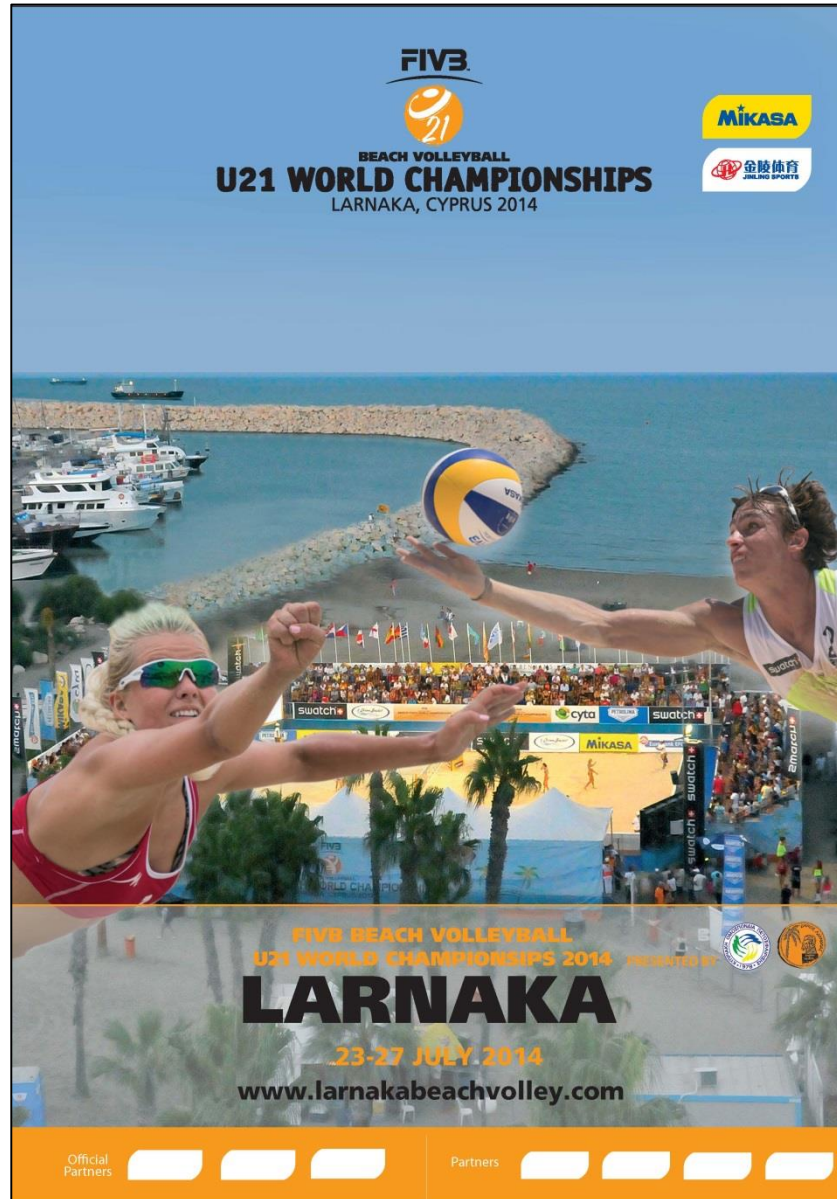
