## VOLLEYBALL TECHNICAL SURVEY GUIDELINES

### TEAM'S INFORMATION

- 1) TEAM'S NAME: complete name of the country in block letters.
- 2) FINAL RANKING: at the end of the competition.
- 3) COACH: Name and nationality from VIS Team's composition data
- 4) USUAL STARTING SIX (+ Libero) DATA
- 5) TEAM'S PERFORMANCE BY SKILL AND TEAM RANKING BY SKILL: from VIS P-5 and P-6 at the end of the competition.
- 6) TEAM'S SYSTEM OF PLAY: Choose 5-1, 4-2 or 6-2
- 7) RECEPTION PATTERN: write the number of participating players (2, 3, 4 or 5)
- 8) ATTACK STYLE: choose the main style from the following options: Quick or Slow, Fixed or Variable or combinations.
- 9) LIBERO UTILIZATION: choose from the following options: Always, Often, Sporadic or Never.
- 10) USUAL LIBERO POSITIONS: indicate position 1, 6, 5 or combinations
- 11) USUAL LIBERO REPLACEMENTS: write the numbers of the players being replaced by the libero.
- 12) JUMP SPIKE SERVICE: write the number of the players who do this action.
- 13) BACK ROW REGULAR SPIKERS: write the number of the players who do this action .
- 14) BACK ROW ATTACK ZONES: select 1, 6, 5 or combinations.
- 15) TEAM'S KEY PLAYERS: write the number of the players (maximum 3).
- 16) TEAM'S MOST VALUABLE STRENGTHS: select 3 from the following list:
  - ✓ Team spirit
  - ✓ Fighting spirit
  - ✓ Jumping ability
  - ✓ Physical strength

- 3) SETTING: Express in a few words the most important characteristic of the setting, like: mainly style of the setters (1<sup>o</sup>-2<sup>o</sup>), often used type of sets and best options, accuracy of the set, tactical adaptation, performance under pressure, side out pattern, etc.
- 4) ATTACKING: Express in a few words the most important characteristic of the attacking, like: aggressiveness, balance risk-errors, block adaptation, use of different technical models, specialists, innovations, etc.
- 5) BLOCKING: Express in a few words the most important characteristic of the blocking, like: reach and positioning, attack adaptation, use of different tactical systems, specialists, error balance, etc.
- 6) DIGGING AND USE OF LIBERO: Express in a few words the most important characteristic of the digging, like: mainly court positions, use of different technical models, specialists, tactical adaptation from different attacks, body reaction, fighting spirit, etc.
