



# 1<sup>st</sup> FIVB Sport Science Award

The FIVB Sport Science Award was established to give an official recognition to significant career contributions in the field of Volleyball Sports Medicine and Science.

In general, the recipient will have established a history of contributions to the field, but in rare cases the recipient may be recognized for a single work that is truly ground breaking and of exceptional significance or elegance.

## Application and Adjudication procedures

The FIVB Sport Science Award - which has been approved by the FIVB Board of Administration during their meetings in 2006 - will be granted during the FIVB Volleyball Medicine Congress 2011, to be held on 13 – 15 January, 2011 in Bled, Slovenia. Thereafter, such award will be granted on a yearly basis subject to an adequate number of candidates.

The FIVB is looking forward to receive applications for candidates with career contributions in the field of Volleyball Sports Medicine and Science **until 15 November, 2010**. Candidates may nominate themselves. Active FIVB Commission members are ineligible for the award.

A five-person selection committee - which will consist of two members from the Medical Commission (including the President, who shall chair the committee), and one member from each of the following FIVB Commissions: Coaching, Technical, and Development – will select from the received nominations. In cases where a vote ends in a tie, the President of the FIVB shall cast the deciding vote.

The winner shall be invited to make a presentation to the FIVB Volleyball Medicine Congress 2011 delegates and the FIVB Medical Commission during a dinner ceremony, where he will receive a FIVB medal and a prize in the amount of \$ 5,000.
