



FIVB WOMEN'S WORLD OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION PREVIEWS DAY 3 – MAY 22, SAN JUAN

Algeria - Colombia

Head-to-head

- Algeria and Colombia have never met at a world level tournament.
- Algeria have met a South American side once at the Olympic Games. In 2008, they lost in straight sets against Brazil.
- Last year, Algeria lost both of their meetings with South American teams, both at the 2015 World Cup. Argentina and Peru both proved too strong in straight sets.
- Colombia's last two meetings against a CAVB side were against Kenya. They won 3-0 at the 2015 World Grand Prix and 3-0 earlier this tournament.

Algeria

- After losing their opening two matches at the World Olympic Qualifying Tournament, Algeria can no longer qualify for the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.
- Algeria finished joint-11th at both the 2008 and 2012 Olympics Games, failing to claim a single win.
- Yasmine Abderrahim recorded a match-high 30 points in Algeria's 3-1 defeat against Kenya on Saturday.

Colombia

- Colombia have never been present at an Olympic Games.
- Colombia can become the fourth CSV country to participate at the Olympic Games after Peru, Venezuela and Brazil
- Amanda Coneo contributed a team-high 13 points in Colombia's 3-0 defeat over Puerto Rico.



Puerto Rico - Kenya

Head-to-head

- The last two meetings between Puerto Rico and Kenya at world level both came at the world championship.
- Puerto Rico beat Kenya on both occasions - 3-1 in 2002 and 3-0 in 2010.
- Puerto Rico have won their last five matches against CAVB sides, including against Nigeria at the World Olympic Qualification tournament in 2004 (3-0).

Puerto Rico

- Puerto Rico need to win one set against Kenya to secure qualification for the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.
- Puerto Rico are hoping to qualify for their first Olympic Games. They can become the sixth NORCECA country to qualify after Canada, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Mexico and United States.
- Puerto Rico have won their first two matches at the World Olympic Qualifying Tournament, both by a 3-0 scoreline.
- Stephanie Enright was Puerto Rico's top scorer last match against Colombia (3-0) with 17 points.

Kenya

- Kenya can no longer qualify for the Rio 2016 Olympic Games.
- Kenya followed up a 3-0 defeat in their opening match against Colombia with a 3-1 victory over Algeria on Saturday.
- Brackcides Khadambi was Kenya's top scorer in each of Kenya's first two matches at the World Olympic Qualifying Tournament. She recorded eight points against Colombia (3-0 loss) and another 23 against Algeria (3-1 win).
